Jim Ryan, Volusia County Emergency Management Director

- Hurricane preparedness
- Fuel management- Topic of discussion was the fact that there may be a distribution problem if large event takes place.
- Pet Shelters-are available for peoples pets (dogs, cats, etc). Some hotels now allowing pets to stay.
- Home Inspections- state will subsidize home inspections and retrofitting of homes for hurricanes. Low income 100% reimbursed. Non-low income matching funds available. [www.mysafeflorida.com](http://www.mysafeflorida.com).
- Tsunami's-Volusia County has Tsunami plan.
- Shelters-32 available.
- HB-7121- requires generators at gas stations within 1 mile of evac route.
- Manager's advisory group. Conferences with all City managers during event.

Mobile Home repairs-Dave Hakojarvi.

- Volusia County does not issue permits for repairs but allows work.
- DeLand, Port Orange, Deltona, Ponce Inlet do issue permits.
- Discussion involved scope of work not exceeding 80% of the value of the manufactured home as long as work was being conducted by a licensed contractor.
  - Dennis Fisher had a permit application submitted several weeks ago involving replacement windows. It was generally agreed that the windows would have to meet manufacturer's specifications to be installed and that a permit could be issued, that way, there is an inspection and a licensed contractor responsible for the work.
